The University of Bayreuth is a research-oriented university with internationally competitive, interdisciplinary focus areas in research and teaching. The newly founded Faculty of Life Sciences: Food, Nutrition & Health on the University of Bayreuth's satellite campus in Kulmbach is currently seeking to appoint a



Full Professor of Law and Economics of Health and Risk Regulation

at pay grade W 3 (minimum salary per month: 7,217 euros) to commence as soon as possible. This is a permanent civil service position.

Applicants should cover German, European, and international health and risk law in research and teaching. We are looking for a legal scholar who can also cover the economic foundations of the subject in research and teaching. A particular affinity with questions of digitalization and data law, e.g. questions of big data and machine learning, would be an asset. Interest in the scientific treatment of issues relating to food law would be an advantage. Applicants who have only partially addressed the above-mentioned fields so far, but who are willing and able to make them the focus of their work, are also invited to submit their applications.

Active collaboration in the development of the newly founded Faculty of Life Sciences: Food, Nutrition & Health is expected. This also includes the establishment of new degree programmes. Teaching will initially take place in the bachelor's programme Food & Health Sciences, and will gradually be integrated into existing or new master's programmes. We hope to find a university lecturer who, due to his / her qualifications and research orientation, can contribute to linking law with the food and health sciences and participate in joint research projects between the food and health sciences, law, and economics. Experience in working with economists is essential. Secondary membership in the University of Bayreuth's Faculty of Biology, Chemistry & Earth Sciences is possible.

The ability to teach in English is a prerequisite for employment, as significant parts of the teaching programme of the new faculty are offered in English; international applicants must be willing and able to teach in German, at least in the mid-term.
