at pay grade W3 (minimum salary per month: 7,217 euros) to commence as soon as possible. This is a permanent civil service position.

The successful applicant will represent public law, in particular public economic law in a broadly understood sense (including its European dimension), in both research and teaching. He or she must have a proven record in research and teaching in constitutional and administrative law and have a research profile that fits in with the economic law orientation of the faculty. The latter can be demonstrated in particular by a research focus in one of the following areas of law: administrative economic and regulatory law, social and health law, finance and tax law, media and information law, law of sustainability, or law of digitalization. The aim is to recruit a scholar who, due to his or her qualifications and research orientation, can contribute to the networking of law and economics and participate in joint research projects in law and economics.

The willingness to teach courses in a foreign language (for example, in English, French, or Spanish) and to contribute to the LL.B. programme "Law and Economics" is expected. The ability to teach in German is mandatory.
